^{***}This option is ONLY for those that *already* purchased a season pass directly from Swiss Valley. Swiss Valley requires a \$10 registration fee for any pass holder that belongs to a weeknight ski club.

TRANSPORTATION:

On Ski Club nights, buses will leave Schmucker's West (back) parking lot promptly at **4:30 p.m**. and will return by approximately **9:30 p.m**. Rides should be at Schmucker by **9:25 p.m**, **NOTE:** It is very important that ski club members are ready to board the bus on time from SMS and Swiss Valley. I will use the Remind App to update parents on our trip back home. We may not have food or beverages on the bus. Students should eat their snack before we load the buses to or from Swiss Valley.

THE Ski Club Card:

The Ski Club Card is **NOT replaceable!** Do NOT lose this card-it is like cash! If you do not have your Ski ClubCard with you when you arrive at Swiss Valley, you may "borrow" a punch from another club member or you will have to pay for a lift ticket that day. Do NOT laminate your card. Laminated cards will NOT be honored by SV. There is a \$5.00 charge to replace damaged cards, including laminated cards. If your card is accidentally ruined, actual evidence of the card must be brought to Swiss Valley to have the card replaced. The Ski Club card allows students to ski five times (4 with our club and one anytime including weekends). Unused punches on the card are VOID after the 2023–24 season.
